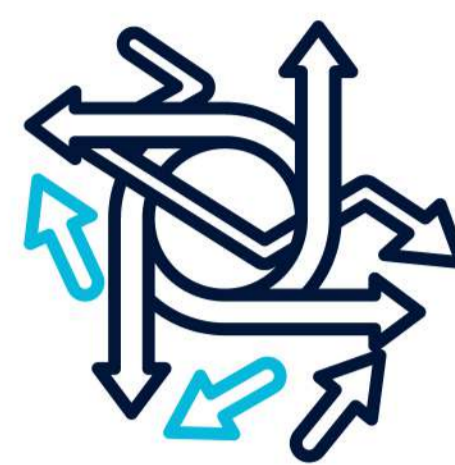
A normal day. A normal task.
